This tutorial will focus on installing Foundation 2014 and a single concurrent license as part of a prerequisite for Hexagon Geospatial desktop products.

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Before you begin, please ensure that you have obtained a copy of your License Authorization Code, otherwise known as your LAC. This code will be needed in order to generate and manage your licenses. If you do not have your LAC, please consult your License Administrator, Software Procurement Admin, or the individual responsible for managing and distributing licenses in your organization.

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Let's begin.

1. Open a web browser and navigate to [www.hexagongeospatial.com](http://www.hexagongeospatial.com).
2. From the **Resources** menu, click on the **Downloads** link.
3. In the search field begin typing `Foundation 2014`.

A list of results will appear.

4. Click on **ERDAS Foundation 2014** and then click **Go**.
5. In the Results field below, click on the **ERDAS Foundation 2014** link and then **Download Now** to begin the download process.

## Installing a Hexagon Geospatial Concurrent License

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If this is the first time downloading any recent Hexagon Geospatial products, you will be prompted to download and install Akamai NetSession Interface, which is used to manage your download. If it was previously installed, your download will begin automatically.

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Let's install the Akamai NetSession Interface.

6. Click the **Download the installer** link and save the file using your browser.
7. Open the folder where you saved the file and double click to launch the installer.
8. Agree to the terms and click **Next** to start the install.

Once the install completes, the download manager will prompt you for a location to store the ERDAS Foundation 2014 zip file.

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9. Choose a location and click **Save**.
10. Click **Close** to close the Akamai installer.
11. Uncheck the **Automatically open when complete** box.
12. Once the download is complete, open the folder containing your download.

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13. Right-click on the **Foundation-v14.0-win.zip** and extract the contents.
14. Launch the **Setup.exe** to start the Intergraph Setup Manager.
15. Expand the Supporting Software tree and select **ERDAS Foundation 2014**.
16. Click the install link to begin the installation.

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A prerequisite to the Foundation install is the Intergraph Licensing.

17. Click **Install** to start the installation.
18. Once the installation is complete, click **Next** to start the Foundation 2014 installation.
19. Click **Finish** when it is done, and then close the Intergraph Setup Manager.

From the Start Menu, launch the Intergraph License Host ID utility under **All Programs > Intergraph Licensing 11.11.1**.

20. In the License Host ID utility, click the **Request License** link to launch the Licensing Portal.

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21. Enter your LAC and click **Continue**.
22. Click **Generate License**.
23. Select your concurrent license and then click **Generate**.
24. Click **Next**.
25. Under Server Hosts, click **Add New Host**.

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26. Select **COMPOSITE** from the **Server Hosts** dropdown menu.
27. Click on the **License Host ID** utility on your Start bar to bring it back into focus.
28. Click the **Copy** button next to the **COMPOSITE** field. Close the License Host ID utility.
29. Right-click in the **Composite** field and select **Paste** to paste the Composite ID and click **OK**.
30. Select the new host and then click **Next**.

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31. Enter your license fulfillment count. You may enter an amount equal to or less than the amount of your available count. In this case, enter 1.
32. Click **Next**.
33. Click **Generate**.
34. Select your license file and then choose your method of delivery.

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You may save the license to your system or email it. For this tutorial, save the file to the system.

35. Click **Save to file** to save the license file to your system.

You may be prompted with instructions within your browser to save the file. Follow the instructions and save the file.

36. Click **Complete** and then **Logout**.

You may also close the browser at this point.

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37. From the **Start** menu, launch the Intergraph Licensing Administration 11.11.1 utility under **All Programs > Intergraph Licensing 11.11.1**.
38. Under the **File** menu choose **Import License File**.
39. Locate your *INGR.lic* file and select it.
40. Click **Open**.

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Your license file will be installed along with your license manager that will be ready to serve licenses. You may expand the Local Server tree to view your available features and licenses.

41. Close the License Administration utility.

Your license is now installed and ready for use.
