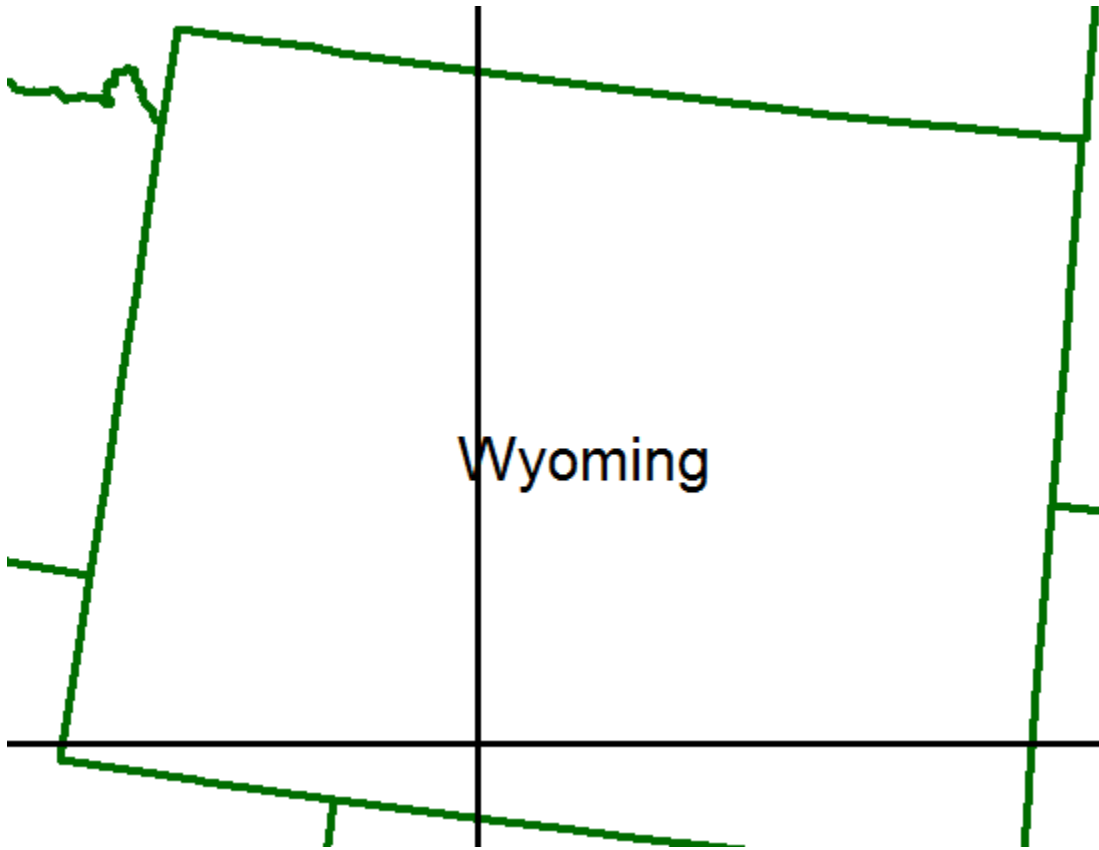
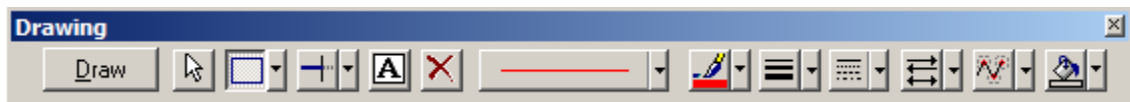


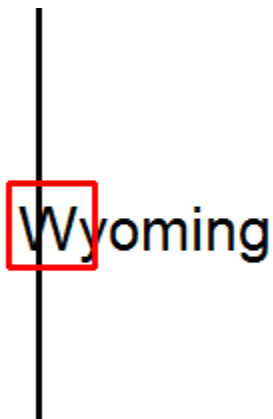
1. Zoom In to the location where the grid line crosses the map label.



2. Use the Rectangle command from the Drawing toolbar to place a rectangle at the location of the label so that it crosses the grid line.



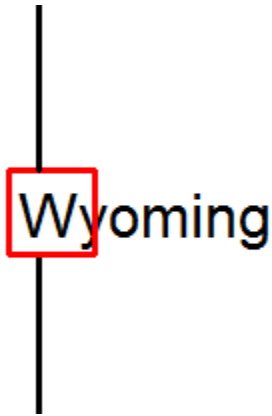
The graphic below shows an example of a rectangle (in red) placed at the location where the vertical grid line passes through the label.



3. Use the 'Trim To Intersection' command from the Drawing toolbar to select the portion of the grid line within the rectangle to remove that part of the grid line.



This will delete that section of the grid line within the rectangle as shown in the graphic below.



4. You can now use the same 'Trim To Intersection' to swipe across the horizontal and vertical lines of the rectangle to remove it or alternately use the Delete command from Drawing toolbar to delete the rectangle. The end result will be a gap in the grid line at the label location as shown in the graphic below.
